

Vocational high school Diploma (Bac Professionnel) Services To People and To Communities



Objectives

This diploma can be prepared in 3 years (2 years in certain conditions) and seeks to :

- Contribute to the wellbeing of people in daily life
- Propose activities, improvements
- Organize and evaluate a service activity
- Communicate in professional situations
- Develop community projects

The graduate is involved in providing services to people organizations, either public or private: associations for home care in rural areas, retirement homes, hospitals, nurseries....

Onward opportunities

- **Employment** : access to the profession of social assistant
- **Further education**, based on the level of education : a 2-year technical diploma of higher education (BTS) in Developing and Animating rural communities, a 2-year technical diploma of higher education (BTS) in Social and Family Economy, entry exams for nursing schools, educators

22 weeks of work experience

- 14 weeks with children, elderly or disabled people, at home or in an institution
- 6 weeks, in the final year as part of the student's project
- 2 weeks of collective training course on health and sustainable development

Preparation for the entry to higher education (in the final year)

Possibility to take the BEPA Services to People by continuous assessment

This qualification exempts from taking written tests for entry into monitor, nursing /childcare assistant courses

Admission requirement

- 5th year of high school: after the 4th year of high school or agricultural education or vocational training qualification (CAP)
- 6th year of high school: after a vocational training qualification (CAP), a vocational or a general 5th year of high school
